Scope

JURSE is a forum of excellence where researchers, practitioners and students in urban remote sensing will present and discuss their latest findings and results.

This event is committed to introduce innovative methodologies and technological resources recently employed to investigate urban environments through orbital and airborne remote sensing.

Topics of interest include:

- new data & sensors for urban area remote sensing
- structure detection and characterization in urban areas
- algorithms and techniques for remotely sensed data interpretation in urban areas
- algorithms and techniques for urban area applications
- urban climatology, geology, and geohazards
- RS applications to social science
- RS applications to urban planning and conservation
- urban development and growth pattern
- urban and peri-urban ecology

Paper submission

Prospective authors are invited to contribute by submitting a full paper in English of no more than 4 pages, including illustrations, results and references. Submissions should be formatted in accordance with the IEEE guidelines.

Special sessions

If you want to organize a special session, you should send your proposal to the Program Chairs. The proposal should include:

- session title
- name, address and affiliations of the session's organizers
- list of 5 papers
- list of authors and affiliations
- a short rationale describing the potential impact of the session.

Special session's organizers are expected to attend the conference and chair the session. Please note that authors contributing to a special session should submit their paper using the standard procedure.

Awards

JURSE 2015 will award the best paper presented at the conference and the three best student papers.

The venue will be at the Ecole Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne (EPFL), near the Lake Geneva, in Switzerland. The conference will be held at the Swiss Tech Convention Center, the on-campus convention center of EPFL.
